The Chairman's Letter 2011

Dear Club Members

As we sit in this lovely sun/rain it is somehow difficult to think of Alpbach in the snow, which is probably a good thing as last year was the worst snow many of us can remember. Interestingly all those to whom I have spoken rarely complain, and just talk about the fun they had. Also the Queen's Royal Hussar ski team was arguably the best-trained team in the army championships, despite the poor snow conditions. They were fitter and faster but on the day not quite skilful enough to win... but they were in the money.

I guess the general economic situation also contributed to the fact that there were lower numbers for all our events and consequential loss of revenue. However the Club finances remain healthy.

I told you last year that we planned to widen the aims of the Club by supporting two charities, the British Limbless Ex-Service Men's Association (BLESMA) and the Combined Servicemen's Disabled Ski Team (CSDST). This proposal was approved unanimously at the AGM, last December and reports from both appear later in this newsletter. Of course we remain faithful to the core aims and it has been most heartening to see our young trainees skiing so well, with the enticement of a "Most Improved" award, and the older folk skiing far too fast for their fragile bodies.

With real sadness I have to report that the office, a familiar feature in Alpbach over many years has now come to an end. Changing times, internet bookings & mobile telephones means the office is no longer financially viable. The Club has made arrangements about getting information to Members when they are in Alpbach. These are detailed in the Newsletter.

Finally our heartfelt thanks to:

- Alistair, Lord Strathnaver, the Club's President for his kind offer to run the Membership from his offices and to Evelyn Cameron for undertaking the role of Club Membership Secretary.
- Paula and Jeremy Walker most sincerely for their continued generous support of the Junior Training "Most Improved Awards"
- Linda, our Club Secretary for all her work throughout the year and
- Our two main sponsors Conny of Conny's Sport and Sepp Margreiter, head of Alpbach Ski School.

We are holding a gathering in London on Thursday 20th October which is during the Ski Show week at Earls Court. It should be great fun, so try and make it. Either way, the Committee looks forward to meeting you in Alpbach in the coming season.

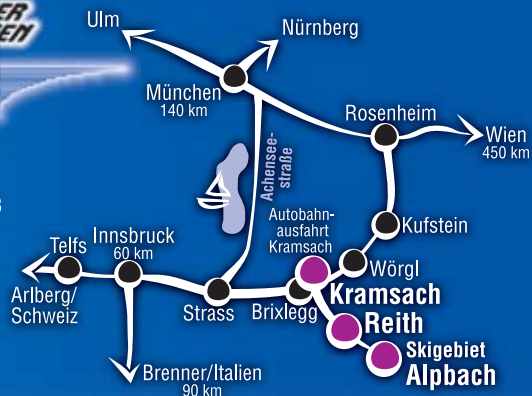

The [new lift](#) from the Schatzberg to the Pechalm mid station is listed on the Wildschonau news but rumour tells us it is not to open until the 2012/13 season. However, I have been informed that they have marked out the pylons near the Pechalm and hope to make a start this autumn. This will add to the existing ski areas on the same ticket.

[An Austrian fable](#) If the old wives tales still apply then this year will be a good winter. BLESMA & CSDST

As reported by the Chairman, the Committee has transferred our Junior Training "Most Improved" concept to our two chosen charities, providing each with a cup to be awarded annually to their Most Improved Newcomer. The cup will remain with the Charity and each recipient is given an engraved salver to keep as a memento. We also donate £500 each year to each of these organisations.

BLESMA particularly encourages ongoing rehabilitation for our wounded servicemen and women, organising a number of different activities each year. One of these is a skibob camp run in Sölden, Austria. This year Keith Walker a Royal Marine above knee amputee was invited to attend. He was very down before the camp, really struggled on his first day and got to the point of giving up. He was persuaded to try again without his prosthetic limb. This made a huge difference – his confidence grew throughout the week; he earned his 'Silver' and became their "Most Improved Newcomer for 2011". He said afterwards "I started to feel like a person who did have a future, there really is life after amputation". Keith now aims to complete his Gold Award and become an instructor for BLESMA

CSDST goes from strength to strength and this year established itself on the international stage; 3 of their athletes competed in the World Championships in Sestriere, Italy with CSDST members winning 11 medals (3 Gold, 4 Silver, 4 Bronze) at International Races in only their second season. Cpl. Ian Bishop RM is CSDST's "Most Improved Newcomer". Two years to the day after losing both legs in an explosion and in his first season racing, he won a Silver Medal at the IPCAS Slalom in Solleftea, Sweden – an

incredible achievement. The Chairman in thanking the Club said "it is tremendous for such a young organisation to have its first piece of silverware".

Both BLESMA and CSDST have asked that their grateful thanks are passed to all members for our "kind sponsorship".

Junior Club Training

We are regularly asked what the club can offer to members and how we differentiate this offering. It is therefore pleasing to report that the children's training is developing strongly and is really beginning to demonstrate 'added value' both to the trainees and to members.

For the first time in several years the Junior Training Committee (JTC) awarded a small sponsorship to a promising trainee. While the club is not yet back to the heights of training British champions, we are bringing children to a high standard whereby they can compete in races. We were delighted to learn that, following in the successful footsteps of her sister Lulu, Immy Adams, won the silver medal in the Macleod Cup at the 2011 School Girls Championships in Flaine. We understand that her sponsorship will go towards a cat suit and hopefully speed her on to gold in 2012!

In light of this success, we are encouraging more of our promising children to participate in such events. We particularly want to see some of our younger trainees have a go, not only to give them something to aspire to but so that we can assess their interest and desire to receive more dedicated race training in the future. We were also pleased to help Gaby Sims with her GCSE PE skiing assessment DVD, which was recognised by her teacher: "Thanks for organising and putting together an extremely detailed and clear DVD for Gaby's GCSE skiing assessment. It truly is excellent... Gaby is clearly a very capable skier and will gain the highest marks".

The club also laid on dual parallel ski events at Christmas and half term on the Böglerfeld, evenings of racing for fun against friends, family and rivals which were open to all (discounted for members).

This is proving an excellent spectacle and we hope to grow the event further in conjunction with Conny's Sport in 2012. Likewise we try to hold a club open race day at the end of the children's Easter training so that parents have an opportunity to pit their skills against their children.

We believe that we have found our niche; training children to a standard above that of normal ski school (not just in Alpbach), providing a forum that allows parents to actively engage and participate in their children's training and assisting where we can with extra-curriculum requests. And all this in a village as wonderful as Alpbach, where the locals really appreciate our presence and commitment.

The training

The 2010/11 season saw 77 trainees over the Half Term and Easter weeks with a number of families becoming AVSC members for the first time. There was increased use of video training, used alongside other specialist training techniques such as snow blades and poles. Our thanks go to our club secretary, Linda, and James Ferguson for giving up their free time to do the videoing. Also our thanks to the instructors who took time out of their evenings to attend dedicated video analysis sessions at the Post Hotel.

The Half Term week was exceptionally lucky with snow; there were two days of heavy snow which allowed off-piste training in addition to the usual training schedule.

The class nominations for 'most improved' were: Catherine Tinker, Hendrik van den Bout, Claudia Kingham and Sophie Galbraith. Hendrik was the overall winner. Congratulations to the week's Race Day winners, Lulu Adams and Joe Turner.

The Easter week was less lucky with snow, as anyone who went skiing in Europe around this time will know. The sun shone and the days were hot. This meant moving the daily start time to 9am at the top and finishing early. On the Thursday afternoon we organised a team walk to the Bischoferalm to give a break from the heavy conditions and allow some fun bonding time between the children in a different environment. This break aside, there was no need to travel to nearby glaciers and the Alpbach lift company managed to keep the slopes going through their nightly piste preparation.

Race day was of course a challenge with none of the main pistes having snow deep enough to take poles. The Alpbach ski school was versatile as ever, setting and managing a course running from the top of the Brandegg lift over the back of the Müliden lift – no mean feat for 100 participants! Our deep gratitude to Sepp, Gerhardt and team for their increased efforts this year.

Nominations for 'most improved' were; Will Womersley, Robbie Cockcroft, Rupert Butcher, Joe Bullman, Molly Fisher, Posie Hall, Guy Tilson, Eddie Cockcroft. Winner of the boys' category was Guy Tilson and Molly Fisher for the girls.

Club champions, for the 4th year running, were Tommy Ferguson and Immy Adams. Congratulations to them both.

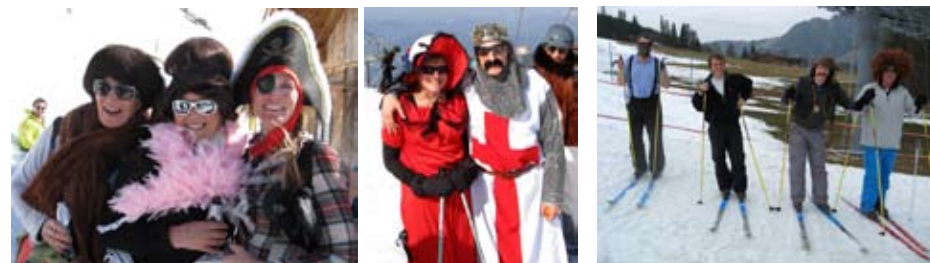
