## Village news

**Congress Centre** Following a 15 month extension building phase the Congress Centrum was ceremoniously presented to the public in the course of the European Forum Alpbach (EFA) on the Tyrol Day on 21st August 2016. The opening celebrations were formally launched by Franz Fischler, president of the European Forum Alpbach in the presence of EU-Commission president Jean-Claude Juncker and the Governors Günther Platter (Province of Tyrol), Arno Kompatscher (Province of South Tyrol) and Ugo Rossi (Province of Trentino).

The Congress Centrum's impressive architecture blends in harmoniously with Alpbach's traditional building style and the surrounding Tyrolean Alpine backdrop. One of the specifications for the extension was to preserve this balance. The results are clear for all to see and is now equipped with the newest up to date conferencing technology, in addition to the multi partible plenary hall, three seminar halls, a spacious foyer and a two-story underground garage..

**Haus Reichsöllner** Many will remember the old 'bottom' Spar in Haus Reichsöllner (opposite the Messner). The demolition of this building started immediately after Easter with many rumours as to what will replace it flying around. We look forward to seeing what turns up.

**Gasthof Roßmoos – extension** The Roßmoos have completed a large extension and now provide 8 family bedrooms with views of the mountains and village, a wellness area with steam bath, sauna and infrared cabin, a new dining room, playroom and fitness room. There is also an elevator.

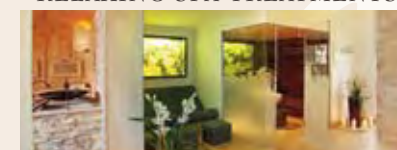

## AFPST and BLESMA

These charities continue to do amazing work in difficult economic times. Every year they contribute so much to those they support and their families.

In his letter, the Chairman has explained that after six years we will, at least temporarily, cease supporting these charities to ensure our reserves are sufficient to sponsor the AICC races in 2017 and our 50th Anniversary in 2018. Both are so important to AVSC and Alpbach. This decision will be revisited after our 50th Anniversary. AFPST will be based at Hintertux over the period of the AICC races and they have the AICC weekend pencilled in their calendar and, subject to their international commitments, will enter a team in the races – a great opportunity to show them what Alpbach can offer.

**AFPST** (formerly CSDST). The name change to Armed Forces Para-Snowsport Team has been made to encompass other snow disciplines such as Langlauf, Boarding etc. and brings them in line with the governing bodies of UK's home nations. Our relationship is primarily with their Alpine Team.

As these athletes gain experience and seed points, they have the XII Paralympic Winter Games in Pyeongchang, South Korea, in March 2018 on their horizon; several AFPST members are hoping for selection.

The courage and determination of these men and women is an inspiration. While some of us were on the beach the Performance Team headed for a successful Summer camp on Norway's Folgefonna Glacier. Much work goes into slope preparation. At the start of the camp a tonne of road salt was delivered to the top, then spread by the bucketful across the training pistes to make the freezing

conditions for the hard training surfaces required for racing – who would want to be a trainer?

At their end of season dinner in May we presented our award for 'the most improved newcomer' to **Ivan Giles**, who was described as "truly amazing". He joined the Royal Signals, completing many operational tours before being diagnosed with PTSD in 2014 and medically discharged the following year after 21 years service. He came to AFPST weighing 17 stone and unable to talk to anyone. He has now come out of his shell, weighs 11 stone, has qualified as both a boot and ski technician and, having learnt to ski in Canada on his last posting, is now a Level 1 ski instructor – a huge turn around. It was good to hear that John Kirk, our most improved skier in both 2013 and 2015 has now returned to training after a serious skiing accident in 2015.

**BLESMA** held a successful skibob camp in Sölden in early March. Sadly we were not in Alpbach at the same time and therefore unable to pop over to support them. There was no nomination for the AVSC 'most improved newcomer' this year. BLESMA have a new Chief Executive, Barry Le Gry MBE, who is reshaping the organisation for today's tough economic world. Veterans, their families and supporters continue to raise money through sponsored activities from charity walks, bike rides and runs including the London Marathon, abseiling down the Spinnaker Tower in Portsmouth and even swimming in the Serpentine in London.

## Junior Training

Last year's children's training took place over two weeks, at half term and Easter.

For half term we averaged around 55 trainees and Easter, close to 60. The average age is somewhat younger at half term and slightly older at Easter but due to the great numbers and support, we were able to offer a comprehensive class range across all ages and abilities. It is really fantastic news for the club that we are getting so many new and young members joining us – at half term we were able to offer three groups containing age ranges 7-9. With children joining us this young, we have a great opportunity to develop them into super skiers (especially as the youngsters are better listeners and more cooperative than their older counterparts!!). Last season was pretty tough for conditions generally and got off to a slow start. The snow came in abundance just before the half term week and for Easter, the pistes held up well. Perhaps the main challenge was the wind – a couple of days where it really blasted across the face. Funny, but I managed to find a number of parents in the warmth of the Ast - we all sympathised with the children as they came in for their lunches...

The format of the training weeks was the same for both and went as follows:

**Days 1&2** – general free skiing with the instructors with limited exercises. The purpose is to get the children's ski legs, push their speed and allow the instructors time to assess them. Some class interchange follows to make sure that they are in the right groups from an ability and confidence perspective. Of course we want the children to be stretched but we also want them to enjoy themselves.

**Days 3-5** – slowing the skiing down somewhat and focusing on technique with videoing on the mountain and playback

in the evenings so that the children can visualise where they need to improve. We also do the dual slalom at this time – it's a fun event but is actually great for technique and builds a little competitiveness. Parents are invited to join and this starts the interactive part of the week and provides opportunity for some family banter!

**Days 5&6** – some dedicated pole training/exercises in preparation for the end of week race, which both children and parents are invited to participate in. We have developed this structure such that it follows a steady build-up of learning and competitiveness, without being daunting. It also encourages parent interaction, given that so many parents feel they don't see enough of their children during school time.

The half term training was led by Gerhard (Knödel) and a team of 8 instructors – Susie & Peter (locals), Dan (ex GB army racer), Athina (Swedish regular), Olivia & Kate (former trainees), Jamie/Rita (interchanged due to illness) and Mike (GB local!). So we had a complete spread of instructors to suit, all of course with good English. Average class sizes were 6 to 7 per instructor – for such a busy week, Sepp and the ski school really did us proud. Congratulations to the nominated 'most improved' from each class – **Ava Harper-Hill, Ed Lucas, Tatiana Martin, Sophie Glabraith, Jack Arthur, Oliver Clifford and Ella Wilmot**. Most improved winners were **Oliver Hughes and Cassie Hobson**. It is so rewarding to see improvement over the week; Cassie was a great example – after a tentative start, she ended up winning her race and even beating the time of some of the older children.

Race day was fantastic – we were able to hold our own race on the Inneralpbach piste and set a relatively long course from

just below the Böglalm. All the children participated from the top – that meant 7 & 8 year olds facing the same challenge as the older teenagers. Fabulous to see waist height children having a crack and finishing with a smile! Congratulations to the group winners; **Herbert Lucas, Kenzie Armstrong, Cassie Hobson, Ed Lucas, Callum Armstrong, Lois Walker, Frankie Walker and Oliver Clifford**. Our overall boy winner was **Hamish Lister** and overall girl winner was **Nancy Walker**.

For Easter training Gerhard was again our chief organiser, but had a sicknote by this stage of the season and so passed the lead on the mountain to **Tweetie (local)** and **Thomas (Sepp's son)**. They were assisted by **Kate, Jess and Olivia (former trainees)**, **Martin (local)** and **Matheus (grandson of one of our former head instructors, Gotts)**. Group sizes were slightly larger at Easter and this, in part, reflected the different nature of the training week – there were more teenagers and more who knew each other from school/other. As such, one of the bigger challenges of the week was keeping friends in the same group while also ensuring standards were broadly similar. The class most improved were **Emily Smart, Elsa Scott, Isabella Reed, Thomas Lindsay and Archie Prior**. Overall most improved winners were **Angus Matheson and Lucia Fairfax**. Well done!

Race day presented somewhat more of a challenge due to the warm weather and consequent snow conditions. After some arm twisting, the lift company agreed to us holding the race on the old Gmah piste running down to finish above the Ast. This was a mighty testing course because Gerhard set it tighter to slow the speed down given the soft snow and consequent ruts. There was therefore no shortage of course incident! As with half term, the little ones also completed the course and a big hats off to them for giving it a go. Special mention to our youngest ever trainee at 6 ½, **Teddy Spur** who's got great potential. Group winners were **Hector**



**Kent, Flora Vestey, Francis Fitzalan-Howard, Fergie Prior, James Stewart Smith and Max Prior**. Special congratulations to our club champions – **Jemima Macfarlane and Harry Reed**; superb racing and great times.

Our thanks as ever go to Sepp at the Alpbach ski school and the instructors who really go the extra mile to make the week a success. I also want to thank the support in the village; our secretary Linda, Vee who helped with club kit sales and of course Mike who does so much of the pre-arrangements. For the coming year, it will be the same team, with Mike back on the slopes.

We are looking for any former trainees who would like to help on the mountain for the training weeks. Simple things like being at the meeting points, providing information and liaising with the instructors. It may not pay well but would be a nice thing to put on a CV for future employment!

## Nancy Walker

Another year of success for AVSC's young star



This year Nancy progressed from under 12 (U12) to the under 14 (U14) age group – a major step in the ski world. Nancy, who trains with the Milton Keynes Ski Race Team on Sundays then plays Netball for Trinity Oxford, is now up against girls attending international ski schools where there is daily training throughout the ski season and glacier skiing in Summer. The U14s also move on to the longer, steeper and more challenging slopes on which adult courses are set. They move from stubbies (short 12" flexible poles) to the full size slalom gates we see racers bashing aside on television. This is a more serious affair with a ranking system through the British Alpine Speed System (BASS) for seed points which also set entry levels for the more important championships

Nancy has thrived at the younger end of her new age bracket. She joined Gerhard's class for the Half Term week, benefitting from skiing on real snow and the longer runs available. In the combined results for the AVSC and Open Race, Nancy had the fastest female finish time, 7.95 seconds behind her uncle, Dan Walker, and nearly 9 seconds ahead of the fastest Open Race lady, Catherine Lister. Then, after a couple of days training with the Gravity Academy, she was off to Les Houches for the British Ski Academy's well run Inter-Schools Championships. Finishing in the top half of both the Slalom and GS races, she easily qualified for a start in the British National Alpine Ski Championships in Tignes at Easter but, with exams looming, this was not possible this year. In May she was in the SATIPSKI races in Hemel Hemstead where her 2nd in the individual U14 competition helped her school to 2nd place, she then came 5th in the U14 Hemel Club National Races. These are very good results which she has capped by winning the Headington School Art Scholarship. We wish Nancy well with her skiing next year and at her new school.

## The Patterson Cup

To remind us of our past and in recognition of the huge part Billy and Dinny played in founding our Club, we now have a smart new trophy.

The Patterson Cup will be awarded each year to the fastest time in the Easter Open Race which is now an established part of our Easter week. In April 2016 we had a good race on the Wiedersbergerhorn with 110 entrants - 54 of them Easter trainees. Dan Walker was the overall winner in an excellent time of 29:59 seconds and becomes the first winner of the Patterson Cup.
