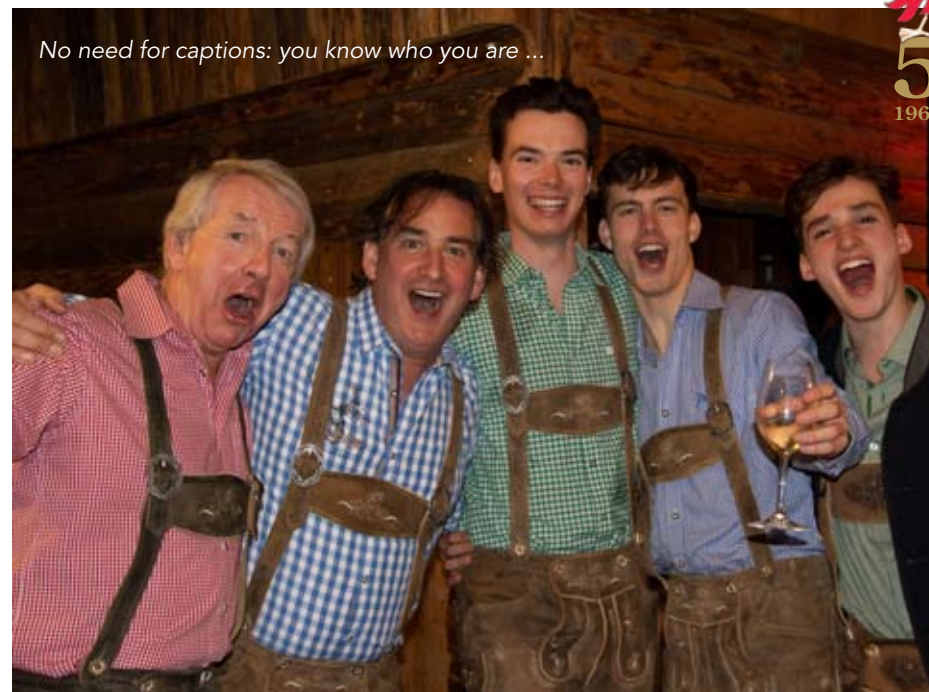

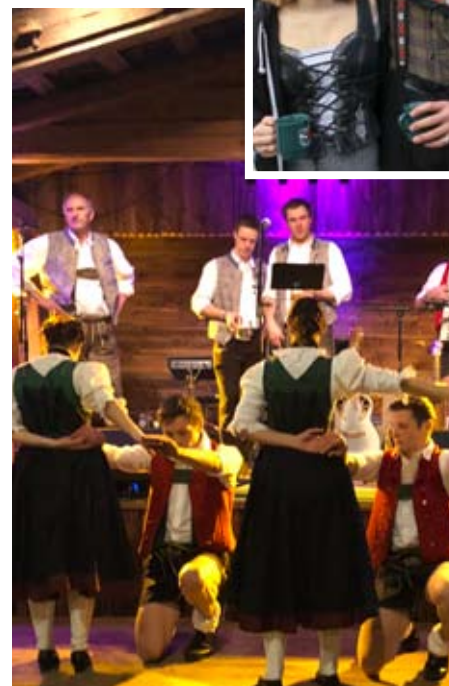

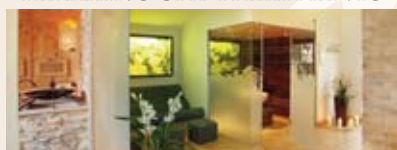

## Junior Training Report 2018

For our 50th Anniversary we had the best snow and more children than we have had for the last 12 years.

The popularity of Half Term skiing has increased over the past few years and the trend continued this year with 74 children and 10 instructors. Half Term is always extremely busy and it is never easy getting the instructors we need and threatened to be even more crowded with most of the continental schools sharing the same Half Term week as well as Fasching. Fortunately, a combination of access to the Wildschönau slopes, additional grooming on the Alpbach side and instructor knowhow made queuing far less than expected. Lunches in the Ast and the Böglalm were crowded but our reservation system worked well and we accomplished what we set out to achieve. Video playback for the classes now takes place during the lunch break in the Böglalm. This is a move away from the after ski sessions in the Post because families found it hard to fit this into their après ski regimes, especially with children in different groups; the new system seems to be a good solution - the main thing being that the children get sight of what they look like when they are skiing which motivates them to improve.

Good snow gave us some off-piste skiing including an excellent Wednesday afternoon when five classes, with thirty seven children, skied down from the Schatzberg Middle Station into the Village itself, finishing on the Böglfelder – something many of the parents will never have done! Some of the children, not even eight years old, had an afternoon they all loved. It took around an hour from top to bottom. They had the full off-piste experience, skiing through untracked deep snow, carefully navigating over farmer's fences, crossing roads and bridges and, as every hardened off-pister will know, having

to do some hiking and trekking to make it all the way back to the village. A truly memorable (and exhausting!) adventure.

Race day in Inneralpbach brought testing conditions for our children and 28 Open Racers. All the Children raced while some parents decided discretion was the better part of valour! Flat light and drifting cloud, at times reducing visibility from about twelve gates down to just beyond three, meant we were ready to pause the start several times. While some racers had better light others had conditions that could only be described as challenging, but that's racing! Mistakes on such courses are easily made, resulting in more falls than usual. Despite this, all the children gave it a really good go, producing some cracking results. Congratulations to [Angus Matheson](#), fastest boy and to [Ella Wilmot](#) our fastest girl. Our two younger classes with Elvira and Nadine coped well from a low start from the track to the Finish Hut, a tough course for the young ones. Each year we put huge emphasis on improvement during the AVSC weeks, so well done our class most improved children [Ollie Herbig](#), [Hannah Hampshire](#), [Sophie Galbraith](#), [Amy-Rose Edginton](#), [Kenzie Armstrong](#), [Arthur Darwish](#), [Freddie Neill](#) and [Harry Wallace](#). The overall Most Improved Girl and Boy were [Molly Prescott](#) and [Brooks Finkel](#).

There was another busy week in April as our AVSC Easter training, with 44 children across six classes coincided with the Club's 50th Anniversary celebrations. The snow was still good but it was warm and the late day pistes became very soft. Our lunches with the better weather and fewer children were less crowded and we were able to access the Böglalm for our BBQ chicken

lunches. Again, select videoing happened on a less formal basis depending on the instructor. The Inneralpbach draglift closed early in the week but we were able to get some parallel slalom and pole work during the mornings on the Mulden slope. As the week continued the warm föhn wind arrived, wiping out much of the snow. Our end of week race options then narrowed as our usual race pistes lacked the depth of snow for poles. Eventually we went higher, to the ridge under the Inneralpbach Pöglbahn Gondola with the start on the track below the top station. A slightly shorter race because of the terrain but Gerhard set an interesting course with some considerable challenges. All the children did very well producing excellent results, including our young class with their low start. The children's races were then followed by 100 Open Racers on the same course! Well done Family [Walker](#), [Frankie](#) the Fastest Boy and [Georgie](#) the Fastest Girl. Our Most Improved nominations, all selected by the instructors were [Luc Dupre](#), [Romilly Clarke](#), [Rosie Straker](#) and [Posy Bryans](#). The overall most improved boy and girl were [Toby Marriott](#) and [Polly Rawlingson-Plant](#). Our joint prize giving was held in the Congress Hall where we were entertained by the very impressive local children's schuhplattler dancers.

We continue to encourage children to ski more and, with their schools, try for the School Girls' and School Boys' Races. This year exam preparation has been the priority for both [Nancy Walker](#) and [Ella Wilmot](#). Nevertheless, when she could, Nancy continued to train with the Ski MK Race Team in the Milton Keynes Snozone coming an overall 6th in the Girls U16s and 17th in the Ladies and another 6th in the U16 ERSA championships. With slightly less school pressure this season, Nancy plans to continue in the Snowzone but also get in some alpine races. Ella has not done a great deal of skiing but got a rowing bronze at the National Schools Regatta in the J16 coxed four and is again thinking of trialling for the British School Girls Championships. We hope to see them both in Alpbach in 2019.

Finally, in our 50th year, a special thank you to Sepp and the Alpbach Ski School, who have partnered us since our start and who continue making a huge contribution to the junior training programme. We get access to top instructors who are often up before our early starts catching the 8am working lift to set our special courses and our own special end of week races. A big thank you to all of them and we look forward to continuing our partnership over the next 50 Years

## Club Weekend Report 2018

The 2018 AVSC Club Weekend proved to be another spectacular extravaganza. A combination of plenty of sun, great pistes, magical off-piste and some cracking racing made for a most memorable weekend.

The majority of the group arrived on Wednesday to blue sky and some of the best snow conditions in the last decade. The program was, as ever, full with many choosing to go off-piste in the Greitalm and the Kohlgruben Alm on Thursday and Friday. A popular addition to the program was a parallel slalom on Friday evening on the Böglersfeld. Glorious sunshine and a 'popup' bar provided a perfect backdrop for some great racing. In a close fought competition that culminated in a knockout it was eventually won by Ben Rohe with Bob Pratten coming a close second despite having to ski with one pole having dislocated his shoulder in a previous crash. A special mention should be made to Gerhard who kindly added a jump into the course providing spectators with the added bonus of some eye watering falls - best of which was awarded to Alex Phillpott. Our grateful thanks to the Alpbach Ski school for setting up the course and for their relentless grooming of the race piste, to the Lift Co for allowing us to use the Böglersfeld after their normal working day and for Linda who did so much to help.

The weather was once again kind to us on Saturday with the Open Race scheduled for a 10.30 start in Inneralpbach from the hut opposite the Böglalm to the Finish Hut. With over 40 entrants, the race was eventually won by Georg Speckbacher with Henry Anstey Jnr coming 2nd and

Frank Chitty 3rd. Sophie Anstey was the speediest lady. The traditional prize giving followed at the chicken shack, Böglalm, where Joey presented prizes on behalf of Konny. We remain grateful to both Konny and Sepp for their continued support.

The remainder of the day was spent watching Six Nations Rugby followed by an excellent dinner in the Jakober.
